PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Dysphagia, weight loss and epigastric pain. Gastroscopy: distal esophageal ulcerated mass narrowing lumen.
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsy.

GROSS:

Soft tissue pieces collectively measuring 1 x 0.9 x 0.9 cm, totally embedded.

MICROSCOPIC:

Focally ulcerated squamous epithelial fragments with underlying malignant infiltrate formed of large round cells with hyperchromatic nuclei and eosinophilic cytoplasm with focal vacuolation. The infiltrate is admixed with inflammatory cells. The main possibility is poorly differentiated adenocarcinoma. However, marker study (CK, Synaptophysin, P63, CD20, and LCA) is recommended for confirmation and exclusion of the less likely other possibilities.

DIAGNOSIS:

Distal esophageal mass, endoscopic biopsy:

- Undifferentiated malignant large cell tumor, high grade.
- Recommended for subtyping by marker study.
