PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Enterocutaneous fistula.
Nature of specimen.	Excision of part of intestine and peritoneal biopsy. ? Tuberculosis.

GROSS:

Two samples were submitted: (1) Fatty fragments of collective size 1.3x1 cm. (2) Friable tissue Fragments of collective size 9x7x1.7 cm.

MICROSCOPIC:

There is extensive and near complete ulceration of intestinal mucosa with related dense infiltration by neutrophils, lymphocytes, plasma cells and macrophages. Inflammation extends to serosa with capillary proliferation and fibrosis. Peritoneal tissue shows similar inflammatory infiltrate with associated fat necrosis and fibrosis. No evidence of specific granulomas. No evidence of malignancy.

DIAGNOSIS:

Intestinal resection and peritoneal biopsy:

- **Inflammatory enteric fistula (non-specific) with ulceration, perforation, fibrous adhesions and peritoneal fat necrosis.**
- **Negative for specific granuloma and malignancy.**
