PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Upper endoscopy reveals a large, recently bleeding ulcerative lesion on the incisura angularis that extends to the antrum and upper gastric body, covered with white exudates, fresh blood, and black clots.
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsies.

GROSS:

Soft tissue fragments collectively measured 1.2 cm, totally embedded in one cassette.

MICROSCOPIC:

Ulcerated gastric mucosal fragments infiltrated by an invasive moderately differentiated adenocarcinoma. The tumor is composed of crowded, irregular, and angulated and cribriform glands exhibiting fused and back-to-back architecture with minimal intervening stroma. These neoplastic structures are set within a desmoplastic background and are lined by atypical epithelial cells demonstrating nuclear enlargement, hyperchromasia, pleomorphism, loss of polarity, and prominent nucleoli.

DIAGNOSIS:

Gastric ulcer, endoscopic biopsy:

- Tubular adenocarcinoma, grade 2.
