PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Post-menopause, presenting with lower abdominal pain, dyspareunia, and a cervical ulcer.
Nature of specimen.	Pap smear for cytology examination.

GROSS:

Two smears were submitted and stained with pap.

MICROSCOPIC:

Smears shows unremarkable squamous cells, satisfactory for evaluation with present endocervical / transformation zone components. There is associated moderate inflammatory changes without identified clue cells. Monilia hyphae and spore forms are identified. No evidence of viral or trichomonal infection. No evidence of atypical or malignant cells.

DIAGNOSIS:

Pap smear, conventional cytology:

- Satisfactory for evaluation.
- Negative for intraepithelial lesion or malignancy (NILM).
- Organisms: Monilia.
- Moderate neutrophilic infiltrate.
- Clue cells are not identified.
