PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Following an IUD procedure, the patient developed peritonitis with abdominal pain, necessitating an exploratory laparotomy that revealed a distal ileum perforation, the margins of which were sent for histopathology to rule out inflammatory bowel disease.
Nature of specimen.	Segmental resection

GROSS:

Small bowel segment designated as "distal ileum," measuring 2.8 x 1 x 1 cm, totally embedded.

MICROSCOPIC:

Ileal mucosa shows focal ulceration with related dense infiltration by lymphocytes and plasma cells and perforation. Related serosa shows moderate to marked infiltration by inflammatory cell with fibrosis. No evidence of specific granulomas.

DIAGNOSIS:

Terminal ileum, segmental resection

- Active inflammatory ulceration with perforation and peritonitis.
- Negative for tumors.
