PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Longitudinal ulcer in the transverse colon, with a clinical suspicion of Inflammatory Bowel Disease or drug-induced colitis.
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsies.

GROSS:

Soft tissue fragments collectively measured 1 cm, totally embedded in one cassette.

MICROSCOPIC:

Partially ulcerated rectal mucosa with related capillary proliferation and dense infiltration by neutrophils, lymphocytes and plasma cells admixed with large round atypical hyperchromatic cells. Such infiltrate is suspicious but inconclusive of underlying malignancy. Marker study (CD3, CD20, CD68 and CK) is recommended to establish definitive diagnosis.

DIAGNOSIS:

Colon ulcer, endoscopic biopsy:

- Active inflammatory ulceration with septic granulation tissue & atypical large cells, inconclusive for malignancy.
- Recommended for marker study.
