PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Clinical suspicion of intestinal schistosomiasis following a macroscopically normal colonoscopy; rectal biopsy submitted for histopathological confirmation.
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsies.

GROSS:

Soft tissue fragments collectively measured 0.6 cm, totally embedded in one cassette.

MICROSCOPIC:

Intact colonic and rectal mucosa mildly infiltrated by lymphocytes and plasma cells with lymphoid follicles. Mucigenic cells are intact. Some neutrophils are seen infiltrating glands but there is no evidence of crypt abscesses. No evidence of bilharzia ova. No evidence of atypia or malignancy.

DIAGNOSIS:

Rectum , endoscopic biopsies:

- Mild follicular proctocolitis with minimal inflammatory activity.
- Negative for bilharziasis.
- Negative for dysplasia and malignancy.
