PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	A female patient presenting at 26 weeks of gestation with acute abdominal pain, diagnosed preoperatively with abruptio placentae; intraoperative findings revealed severe adhesions, pus inside the abdomen, and infected myoma.
Nature of specimen.	Ascitic fluid for cytology.

GROSS:

One smear was prepared and stained from submitted 5 ml grey pus.

MICROSCOPIC:

Smear shows a marked number of degenerated neutrophils and small lymphocytes with many cell debris and few reactive mesothelial cells. No evidence of atypical or malignant cells.

DIAGNOSIS:

Ascitic fluid, cytology:

- **Marked (suppurative) inflammatory changes.**
- **Negative for malignant cells.**
- **Category Class II according to The International System for Reporting Serous Fluid Cytopathology.**
