PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Scattered patchy hyperemia in the sigmoidal mucosa, and an irregular, polyp-like mucosal growth with slightly thickened surrounding mucosa located just above the anorectal junction.
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsies.

GROSS:

Two biopsies were submitted:

- 1- Sigmoid: soft tissue fragments collectively measured 0.6 cm, totally embedded.
- 2- Rectum: soft tissue fragments collectively measured 0.5 cm, totally embedded.

MICROSCOPIC:

- 1- Intact colonic mucosa mildly infiltrated by lymphocytes, neutrophils and plasma cells. Few neutrophils are seen infiltrating glands this indicating activity. Mucigenic cells are intact and no evidence of crypt abscesses. No evidence of atypia or malignancy.
- 2- Polypoid lesion formed of hyperplastic focal ulcerated colonic glands with preserved mucigenic activity. Stroma is fibrotic and shows mild chronic inflammatory reaction composed of lymphocytes and plasma cells. No evidence of specific granulomas. No evidence of crypt abscesses. No evidence of atypia or malignancy.

DIAGNOSIS:

1- Colon, endoscopic biopsy:

- Mild chronic non-specific colitis with minimal inflammatory activity.
- Negative for malignancy.

2- Rectal polyp, excision:

- Hyperplastic polyp, inflamed and focally ulcerated.
- Negative for dysplasia and malignancy.
