PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	The entire mucosa looks moderately hyperemic, edematous, with large clean base ulcer at incisura angularis.
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsy

GROSS:

Soft tissue fragments collectively measured 1 cm, totally embedded.

MICROSCOPIC:

Focally ulcerated gastric mucosa showing moderate atrophy of glands and moderate infiltration by lymphocytes and plasma cells. Some neutrophils are seen infiltrating glands thus indicating activity. H. pylori characteristic forms are seen colonizing glands. No evidence of intestinal metaplasia, atypia or malignancy. Recommended for follow up.

DIAGNOSIS:

Gastric ulcer, endoscopic biopsy:

- H. pylori-associated moderate chronic atrophic gastritis with associated active inflammatory ulceration.
- Negative for malignancy.

Comment:

- Follow up endoscopy after treatment is advised to ensure regressive course of ulcer. If malignancy is still suspected, rebiopsy is then to be considered.
