Clinical Information.	Cholecystectomy
Nature of specimen.	Cholecystectomy

GROSS:

Received open gallbladder measuring 7x3.5 cm, showing ulcerated mucosal surface, rubbery area measured 5 cm, and a thickened wall measuring up to 1.2 cm in thickness.

MICROSCOPIC:

Gall bladder wall shows marked fibrosis with extensive mucosal ulceration and marked infiltration by neutrophils, lymphocytes and plasma cells, forming an abscess cavity. Glands exhibit focal cystic dilatation and appear to be entrapped within muscular coat (Rokitansky-Aschoff sinuses). This inflammatory reaction is seen extending to serosal surface. Some foci showing liver tissue attached to the serosal surface of the gall bladder and infiltrated by the same inflammatory infiltrate. No evidence of specific granulomas. No evidence of tumors.

DIAGNOSIS:

Gall bladder, Cholecystectomy:

- Acute on top of chronic calcular cholecystitis with abscess formation.
- Negative for malignancy.
