PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Chronic abdominal pain and highly elevated fecal calprotectin (> 900 mg/gm), found on colonoscopy to have multiple hemorrhagic ulcerated lesions in the hepatic flexure, 70 cm from the cecum, highly suspicious for Inflammatory Bowel Disease versus infectious colitis.
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsy

GROSS:

Soft tissue fragments collectively measured 1 cm, totally embedded.

MICROSCOPIC:

There is focal ulceration of colonic mucosa with reduced mucigenic cells and related dense infiltration by neutrophils and lymphocytes, amounting at crypt abscess formation in some areas. No evidence of dysplasia. No evidence of malignancy.

DIAGNOSIS:

Colonoscopic biopsy:

- Ulcerative colitis.
- Negative for dysplasia.
