PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Chronic diarrhea underwent a colonoscopy that revealed multiple sessile lesions at the caecum and ileocecal valve.
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsy

GROSS:

Two biopsies were received:

- 1- Cecum: soft tissue fragments collectively measured 0.7 cm, totally embedded.
- 2- Colon: soft tissue fragments collectively measured 0.5 cm, totally embedded.

MICROSCOPIC:

- Polypoid lesion formed of hyperplastic intact colonic glands with preserved mucigenic activity. Stroma is fibrotic and shows mild chronic inflammatory reaction composed of lymphocytes and plasma cells amounting at lymphoid follicle formation. No evidence of specific granulomas. No evidence of crypt abscesses. No evidence of atypia or malignancy.
- Intact colonic mucosa mildly infiltrated by lymphocytes and plasma cells with lymphoid follicles. Mucigenic cells are intact. Some neutrophils are seen infiltrating glands but there is no evidence of crypt abscesses. No evidence of atypia or malignancy.

DIAGNOSIS:

Cecum , endoscopic polypectomy

- Hyperplastic polyp, inflamed.
- Negative for malignancy.

Colon, endoscopic biopsy:

- Mild follicular colitis with minimal inflammatory activity.
- Negative for dysplasia and malignancy.
