PATHOLOGY REPORT

Clinical Information.	Bile induced gastritis and rectosigmoiditis.
Nature of specimen.	Endoscopic biopsies.

GROSS:

Two containers were received:

- 1- Gastric: soft tissue fragments collectively measured 1.2 cm, totally embedded.
- 2- Colon: soft tissue fragments collectively measured 1.2 cm, totally embedded.

MICROSCOPIC:

- Gastric mucosa showing mild atrophy of glands and moderate infiltration by lymphocytes and plasma cells. There is evidence of focal inflammatory activity manifested by few neutrophils infiltrating glands, however H. pylori characteristic forms are not seen. No evidence of intestinal metaplasia, atypia or malignancy.
- Intact rectosigmoid mucosa mildly infiltrated by lymphocytes and plasma cells. Mucigenic cells are intact and no evidence of crypt abscesses. No evidence of atypia or malignancy.

DIAGNOSIS:

Stomach, Endoscopic biopsy:

- Mild chronic atrophic gastritis with associated mild inflammatory activity.
- H. pylori are not identified.
- Negative for dysplasia or malignancy.

Rectosigmoid, endoscopic biopsy:

- Mild chronic non-specific proctosigmoiditis.
- Negative for dysplasia and malignancy.
