### PATHOLOGY REPORT

<b>Clinical Information.</b>	Cervical ulcer.
<b>Nature of specimen.</b>	Pap smear for cytology examination.

#### GROSS:

Three smears labeled as endocervix and exocervix and endocervix with exocervix, all were submitted and stained with pap.

#### MICROSCOPIC:

Smears show unremarkable squamous cells, satisfactory for evaluation with present endocervical / transformation zone components. There is no inflammatory changes. No evidence of fungal, viral or trichomonal infection. No evidence of atypical or malignant cells.

#### DIAGNOSIS:

##### Pap smear, conventional cytology:

- Satisfactory for evaluation.
- Negative for intraepithelial lesion or malignancy (NILM).
- Organisms: None.
- No abnormal neutrophilic infiltrate.
- Clue cells are present.
